Subject: RE: Walberton Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan - Reg 14 consultation

Please find below a response from Barnham and Eastergate Parish Council to the above consultation.

Barnham and Eastergate Parish Council has taken a look at the Revised Walberton Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan and has no comments to make on any specific issues but would like to make the following general comments:

There appears to be very little about connectivity with neighbouring parishes (apart from when discussing chalk streams) or permeability of the parishes – however, the Biodiversity Corridors in the Plan do appear to meet up/link with those proposed for the Barnham and Eastergate Neighbourhood Plan.

The Revised Plan makes much of the ‘three distinct villages’ (Walberton, Fontwell and Binsted) but fails to provide a clear strategy for each or how the Plan envisages the three retaining their individuality.

There is also no clear strategy for Fontwell Village except to make it the area in the Parish where the majority of the new house builds should occur to meet the additional housing requirements imposed by ADC.
