New policy VE10: Biodiversity Corridors

- ✓ Arun Local Plan highlights the importance of “connectivity” in our countryside.
- ✓ Wildlife sites such as ancient woodlands are greatly enhanced if connected to other sites giving flora and fauna the chance to spread.
- ✓ These corridors are important features of the landscape – tree lines, hedges and water courses.
- ✓ The ability for species to spread and colonise will be more important through climate change.
