The Dandara (Fontwell Meadows) outline application decision for 400 homes has been postponed yet again by Arun District Council. No one seems to know why? Latest decision date is now 25 November.

Some parishes and towns, both local and national, had very poor turnouts for their referendums and as a consequence sometimes planning applications have gone through. Inspectors didn't feel that the locals felt strongly enough to turn out and vote yes for the local plan. Let's make sure this doesn't happen here.....

Please vote YES in February to help put new housing where we want it should be not where the developers want it.

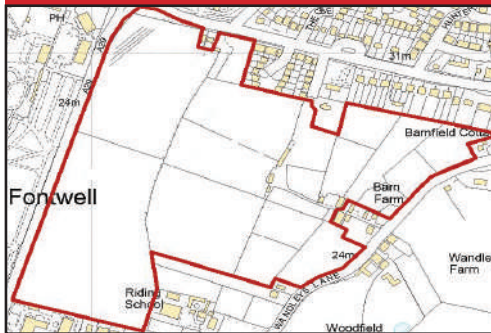
