Council for support. Highways England are currently carrying out "Options Identification" to decide which route(s) (improvements) to put forward for public consultation early in 2017. Two of the options, known as the Binsted Options, would seriously affect Walberton and Binsted. The ABNC are asking the Council to write and object and ask that these options are taken out of the consultation process.

The Chairman allowed Mr M Tristram to address the meeting and explain the ABNC concerns.

Councillors were very supportive of opposing the Binsted Options and resolved to write and support action to have these removed from the consultation. Councillor Camerer Cuss was of the opinion that the Council's objection should be based around normal planning objection issues..
