- 2. WA/80/17/HH. 3 Homefield Crescent, Walberton. Demolition of existing rear conservatory and erection of single storey rear flat roofed extension. This application may affect the character and appearance of the Walberton Green Conservation Area. Comment by 4 January 2018.
