Councillor Mrs Clark, Chair of the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, advised that consultations were being held with their barrister before a reply to Arun District Council's letter of 29th July, 2016 is sent.

29816 Highways issues

- The Arundel bypass Neighbourhood Committee's July 2016 Press Release was noted. Having already written to Highways England about the "Binsted Options" it was considered there was no further action the Council could take at this moment in time. Councillor Mrs Clark said that the "Save Binsted" signs had not yet been removed.
- 2. An email from Mrs E Tristram relating to speed signs in Yapton Lane was considered. The signs partially obscured by vegetation have been reported to WSCC. It was considered that there was no need for additional signage. Councillor Strickland is speaking to the police about the speed limit areas in Yapton Lane. He will keep County Councillor Whittington informed as his support will be needed if applications to vary existing speed limits are made.
